

### Step 3

#### Submit the Completed Grant Application Package

If you are not already connected to the Internet, you will be directed to do so and will need to login to Grants.gov using your username and password.

#### Submitting a Grant Application with Adobe Reader:

After you have entered all the necessary information, checked the package for errors and saved your package; click the "Save & Submit" button on the cover page, your application package will automatically be uploaded to Grants.gov.

A confirmation screen will appear once the submission is complete. A Grants.gov tracking number will be provided at the bottom of this screen, as well as the official date and time of the submission. Record the tracking number so that you may refer to it should you need to [contact us](#) for support.

### Governor Perdue's Certifications of ARRA Stimulus Funds for Georgia's Roadway Projects



The Department of Transportation submitted the first and second list of roadway projects to Governor Perdue on April 2<sup>nd</sup> and April 30<sup>th</sup>, respectively. On June 3<sup>rd</sup>, the third list of projects was certified, approving \$39 million in stimulus transit funds. The fourth round of certifications, for \$146 million in roadway projects, was approved by the Governor on June 12<sup>th</sup>. To date, there have been 160 projects that total \$580 million, and all have been certified by Governor Perdue.
