

Caseworkers and support staff will be in Millen to help residents affected by Jockey International's Decision to Outsource 203 jobs to the Caribbean and Central America

12th District Georgia Congressman John Barrow today announced that his office's weekly Monday outreach hours in Millen, Georgia, will be extended next week in the wake of Jockey International's decision to outsource 203 jobs from their plant in Millen to Jamaica, Honduras, Costa Rica, and El Salvador.
