Washington, D.C. - Today, Congressman John Barrow (GA-12) announced that he is asking residents of Georgia's 12th District to participate in his "Holiday Cards for Our Troops" program.

Throughout this week, Congressman Barrow will collect holiday cards for soldiers who are recovering from battle and stationed away from their families during this holiday season.
